#### for Horizon Europe research funding





For most calls for proposals, you must apply as a team of at least 3 partner organisations from 3 different EU or associated countries.

At least 1 of the 3 partners must be from an EU country.

#### 3 Discover the DOs & DON'Ts

Submitting a project proposal requires careful planning, precise budgeting, and a seamless collaboration with partners.

We have prepared some DOs and DON'Ts to help you prepare a quality proposal.



Communication: Inform, promote and communicate about activities & results.

Dissemination: Make knowledge and results publicly available.

Exploitation: Make concrete use of results.

#### 5 Follow the Open Science principles

Open science is an approach to research that emphasizes the sharing of knowledge, results and tools as early and widely as possible. It is mandatory under Horizon Europe.

### 6 Support gender balance

In Horizon Europe, gender balance among researchers is a ranking criterion for proposals with the same evaluation scores. Integrating the gender dimension is now a mandatory requirement.
